A message to all Genie Professional Line Wholesalers and Dealers:

As you may know, new federally mandated safety standards have designated coin cell batteries as an ingestion hazard. The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission established the ANSI/UL 4200A-2023 safety standards for products that contain these batteries which recently went into effect.

To comply with these requirements and continue shipping complete garage door opener products, it will be necessary for us to temporarily suspend the sales of a limited number of our standalone accessory products. We expect relief from this suspension in approximately 90 days as we complete our new procedures and testing to comply with the law.

We will continue to ship garage door openers with their designated pack-ins (or with a variation thereof) during this time frame. We will not accept orders for the below listed remotes during this time and will honor returned, warranty replacement remotes at a later date.
